

# Examples of Red Flags Signaling Potential Gaps in Health Care-Child Welfare Systems Collaboration

1. The child stays unwell, declines, receives non-standard treatments, or has gaps in health care
2. "No one knows what's going on."
3. The child has remorse for actions and doesn't improve over time
4. Persistently poor grades or delays over time
5. Placement breakdowns/disruptions
6. The child runs away
7. Court orders health care without health professional consultation
8. Requests for unconventional or uncovered procedures/treatment
9. "No one can handle this child."
10. Prolonged hospitalizations with placement disruption
